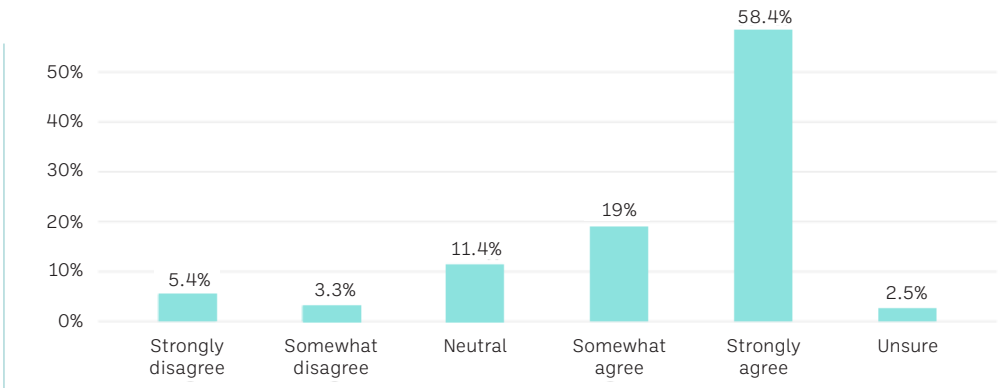
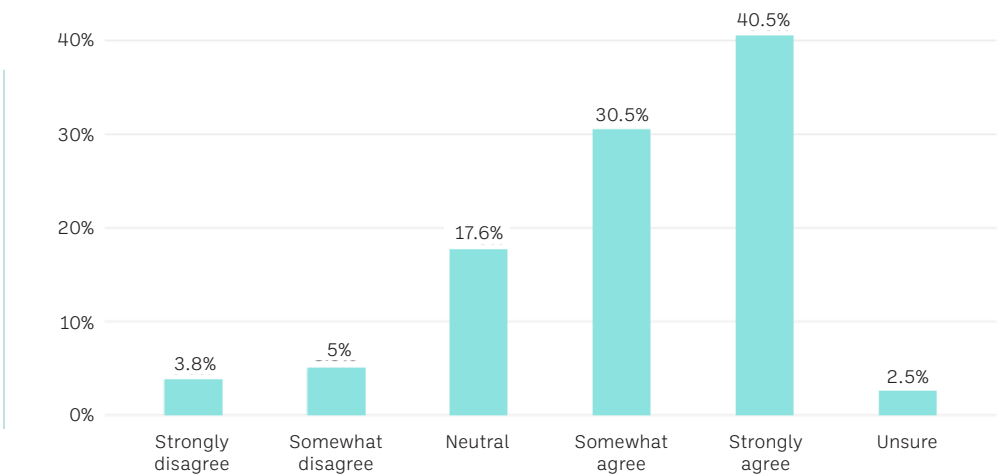


# New polling on AI-generated content, federal election funding, and anti-doxxing protections

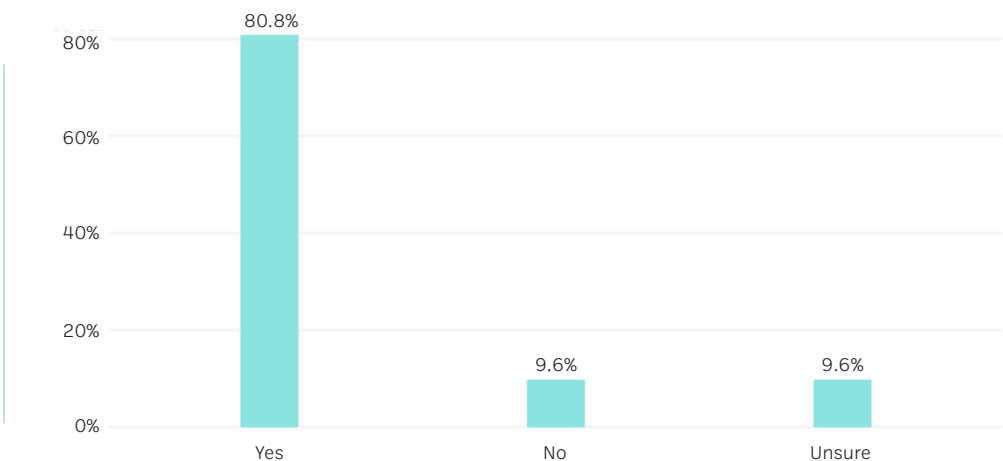
To date, Congress has not passed any laws to safeguard elections from the misuse of Generative Artificial Intelligence technologies. To what extent do you agree or disagree that Congress should take action to address the spread of false election information through the use of fake images and videos generated by artificial intelligence?



Currently, states and local governments fund the majority of election administration costs needed to ensure the ballot count is accurate and transparent, defend against cyber attacks and increase security at polling places. To what extent do you agree or disagree that the federal government should also provide election administrators with regular and consistent funding to help administer elections?



In response to threats against federal judges, Congress enacted a law granting judges the right to protect sensitive personal information such as their home addresses from public disclosure. Election officials have also received similar threats. Do you support extending protections for sensitive personal information — like home addresses and license plate numbers — to election officials?



## Methodology

Citizen Data sampled N = 1,001 registered voters during May 2024 as a part of its monthly omnibus survey. The margin of error is +/- 3.1%. Results are weighted on Party ID, race, age, gender, and education.
