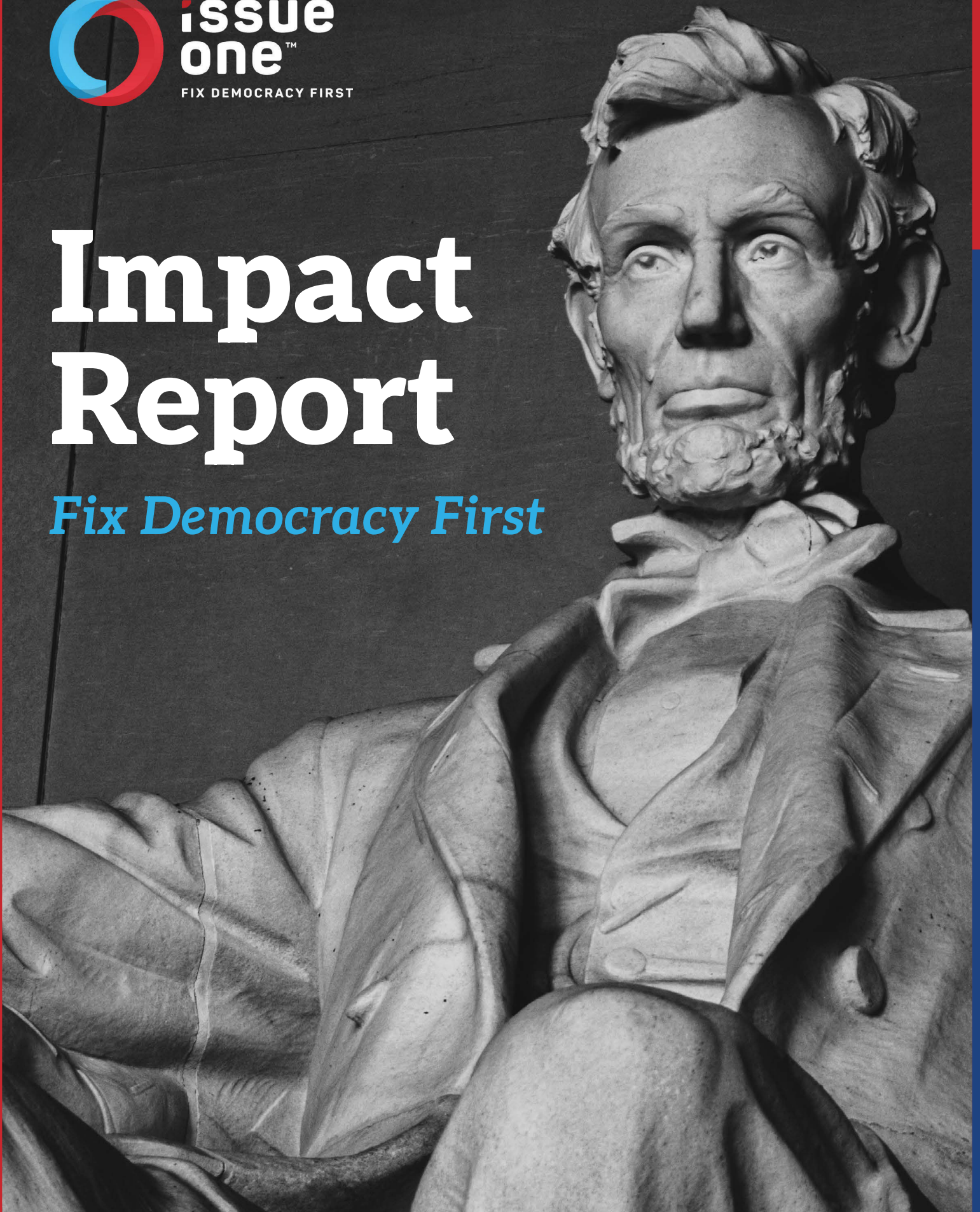

We unite leaders from all political backgrounds, because democracy belongs to everyone.

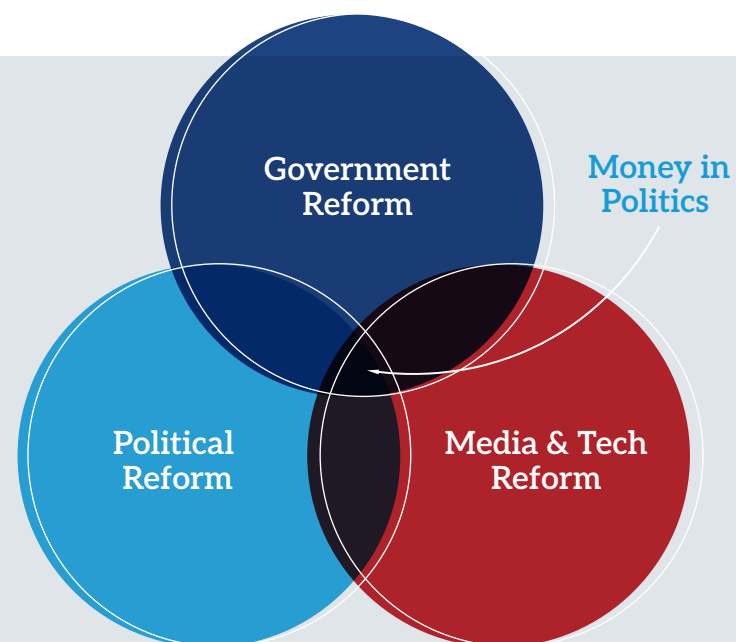
### Federal

# Exposing Money in Politics

This year, Issue One exposed the outsized influence of dark money in our elections and revealed how tech money and lobbying are quietly shaping policy decisions.

Our hard-hitting reports pulled back the curtain on how anonymous donors, tech giants, and well-funded lobbying campaigns increasingly drive policy decisions behind the scenes.

We also led efforts to bring greater transparency to presidential campaigns, shedding light on the elite donors shaping the election and encouraging candidates to embrace transparency to bolster public trust in the political process.

Our commitment to exposing the role of money in politics ensures that voters clearly understand how political decisions are made.

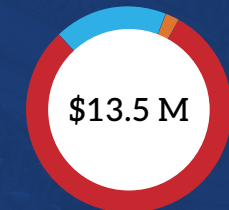

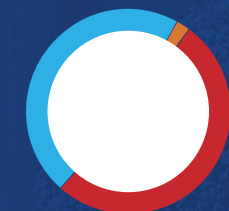
## Total Revenue

- Fee for Service & Miscellaneous Revenue // 2%



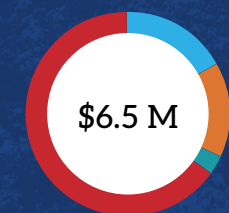
## Revenue Sources
